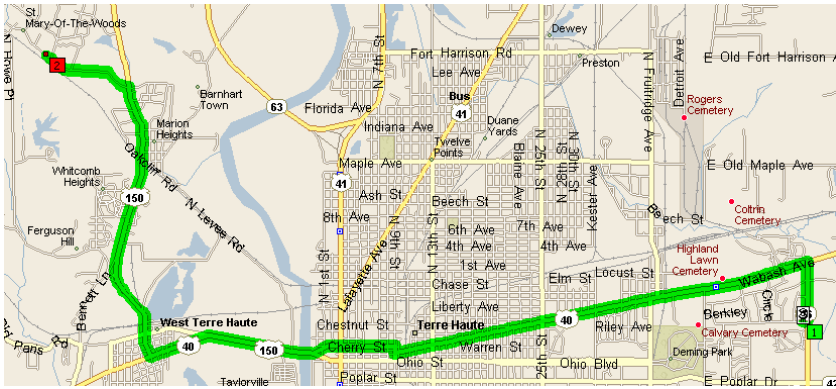

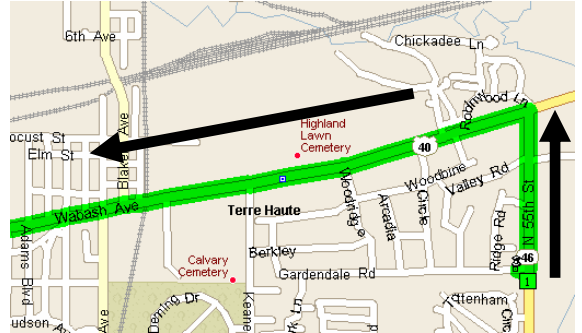

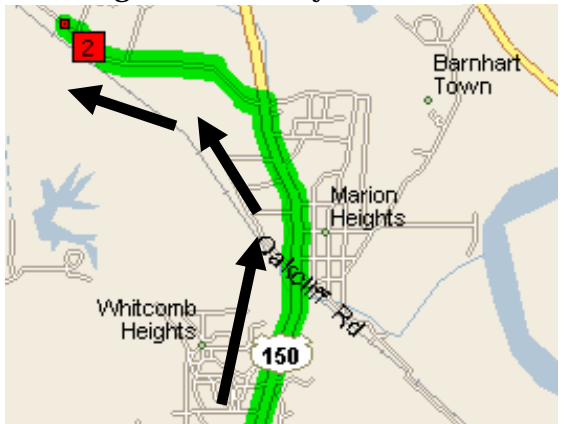

Turn RIGHT (North) onto US-40 [N 9th St]	120 yds
Turn LEFT (West) onto US-40 [Cherry St]	2.3 mi
- Go straight on US-40/150 West	
Turn RIGHT (North) onto US-150	2.7 mi
Turn LEFT (West) onto Saint Marys Rd	0.6 mi
Bear RIGHT (West) onto Saint Marys Rd [St Mary S Rd]	0.3 mi
<b>Arrive 3301 Saint Marys Rd (2nd entrance—MAIN entrance)</b>

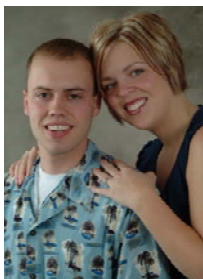
## The Engagement
